POLL OBJECTIVE

The primary objectives of this poll are:

- 1. To assess public confidence in President Ruto's latest cabinet appointees based on their academic qualifications, professional experience, and performance during vetting.
- 2. To gauge public perceptions of appointees' post-appointment performance, including milestones and shortcomings.
- 3. To understand how demographic factors (age, gender, income, geography) influence opinions on the appointees.
- 4. To evaluate the political impact of these appointments regionally and nationally.

INFORMED CONSENT AND CONFIDENTIALITY STATEMENT

Mwelekeo Insights is committed to conducting research with the highest ethical standards. This study on Kenyans' confidence in President Ruto's recent appointees from the Mt. Kenya region was carried out through online surveys and telephone interviews, ensuring informed and voluntary participation.

All respondents were provided with clear information about the study's purpose, their right to withdraw at any time, and assurances of confidentiality before participating. Data was collected ethically, with no coercion, and used strictly for research purposes, and responses anonymized.

METHODOLOGY



DESIGN

National Quantitative Survey



Kenyan adults aged 18 and above who are eligible voters



SAMPLE SIZE

11,879 respondents



SAMPLING METHODOLOGY

Random, multi-stage stratified sampling proportionate to population size



DATE OF FIELDWORK

Date of fieldwork – Feb 21 to March 7th 2025



COVERAGE

Nationally covered, proportionate to population distribution



MARGIN OF ERROR

+/- 3.4% at a 95% confidence level



DATA ANALYSIS

Total level, key demographics (setting, gender, and age)













DEMOGRAPHICS

The survey targeted Kenyan adults aged 18+, all of whom are registered voters. Respondents were sampled from all 47 counties and stratified by region, age, gender, and income levels to ensure a nationally representative dataset. The demographic breakdown was as follows.


AGE DISTRIBUTION

Represents youth perspectives critical for tech and trade-related dockets. 18-34 years (48%)



Captures working-class voters directly impacted by (34%) 35-54 years agriculture and tax policies.


Reflects older voters prioritizing stability and (18%) experience.




GENDER REPRESENTATION




Balanced gender representation ensures diverse views on leadership effectiveness.

Majority low-income respondents 55% highlight sensitivity to tax policies and subsidy programs

High-income earners emphasize trade and 45% ICT infrastructure. They are also sensitive to tax policies

















- Opaque maize import negotiations with Tanzania.
































Overall confidence in leadership

General confidence levels in Lee Kinyanjui's ability as a leader and CS for Trade and Industrialization

























POLITICAL IMPACT OF APPOINTMENTS

General Background

The recent high-level appointments by President Ruto have had varying impacts on the political landscape, especially within different regions of Kenya. The public perception of these appointments has influenced political dynamics, voter sentiments, and potential alignments ahead of future elections.

Regional and National Impact

APPOINTEE	MT. KENYA REGION IMPACT	NATIONAL IMPACT
Lee Kinyanjui	Strengthened political influence in Nakuru; Increased support from business communities.	Elevated profile as a trade expert; Possible political comeback.
William Kabogo	Strengthened impact due to bold approach to political issues, mobilization skills; solidifies position as a top figure to safeguard region's political interests.	Criticism over leadership style; Public perception affected by online interactions.
Mutahi Kagwe	Mixed reception in rural Nyeri county which is also backyard to impeached Deputy President Rigathi Gachagua.	Mixed national reception due to past COVID-19 handling controversies.













GENERAL IMPACT OF RUTO'S RECENT APPOINTMENTS

Region	Change in Ruto's Support (%)
Central Kenya (Kabogo & Kagwe's base)	+10%
Nakuru County (Kinyanjui's base)	+8%
ASAL Regions (Pastoralist communities)	-5%
Coastal Regions (Trade & Port concerns)	-7%
Nairobi (Urban Youth, Tech Sector)	-12%

Lee Kinyanjui



- > "His tenure as governor was marked by significant infrastructure development in Nakuru."
- "Despite his election loss, he remains a respected figure in local politics."
- "Some residents believe his policies favored urban areas over rural communities."
- > "We had been enjoying Kinyanjui's wise parables that were hitting Zakayo below the belt, but now that he's CS, his mouth is too full to give us those wise teachings. We miss the parables.

Mutahi kagwe



- → "His leadership during the COVID-19 pandemic was both praised and criticized."
- → "Allegations of mismanagement of COVID-19 funds have tainted his reputation."
- → "His communication style was clear, but some felt it lacked transparency."
- → "Admitting that Covid-19 pandemic was money-minting opportunity for the political
- class while Kenyans died should land him in jail, not a cabinet position."
